Parent Commitment and Financial Obligation Agreement

Congratulations on being accepted as a member of Westside United F.C. Players are expected to make a dedicated commitment to their respective teams. As parents, you will be expected to make a commitment to the Club. To be a member of Westside United F.C. and remain in good standing you and your player must:

- Agree to pay all Team fees and Club fees as scheduled. Players, at the discretion of the Board of Directors, may be considered ineligible to participate in team activities until ALL Team Fees and Club Fees are paid. Westside United reserves the right to "pull" or "withhold" any player card due to non-payment of Team Fees or Club Fees.
- 2) Agree to fulfill your obligation to play for the team for which you were selected for one full year. One full year is defined as including both the Fall Season and the Spring Season. No player will be released from the Club until ALL fees for the full commitment period are paid in full. If, for any reason, a player IS NOT going to play for a full year (with the exception of high school age players) you agree to notify the coach and get approval to play for just one season from the Director of Coaching. Fees will be adjusted accordingly for one season.
- 3) Injury Policy: If the injury is short term (3 months or less), no REFUND will be provided. If the injury is long term (more than 3 months) medical proof must be provided and a meeting will be held to determine a possible refund. Westside United reserves the right to hold any player card due to non-payment for any reason. Any injury must be reported to the coach and DOC. Any adjustment or refund of fees will be discussed and approved by the Board.
- 4) Agree to support Westside United by taking part in "volunteer" opportunities throughout the fall season and the spring season. Every parent is expected to volunteer for the Westside United Invitational for one 2 hour slot per player; other volunteer opportunities include, but are not limited to: general field maintenance, getting fields ready for the season, tearing down fields at the conclusion of the season. Consideration might also be given to volunteering for a position with your individual team.
- 5) Agree to support the Westside United F.C. fundraising event which occurs every spring season. All families are expected to participate in the Club fundraising event either through active participation or through a "buy out" option. Non-participation is NOT an option. Parents who choose the "buy out" option agree to pay the full "buy out" amount (as determined by the specific fundraising event) when the due date is determined.
