SCOPE:

As part of the BYSC Technical Staff and reporting to the Technical Management Team, this position is responsible for providing leadership and overseeing the development of one of the Club's development program teams including the player development that is aligned with the Club's Vision and Mission. The position manages all aspects of the development program team including its games, practices, off field activities and program/season planning and curriculum.

- Technical
 - In alignment with OSA Long-Term Player Development, plan, develop and execute age appropriate training sessions and curriculum.
 - Travel with the team and attend all competitions.
 - Oversee scouting, identification and selection of players into the OPDL team.
 - Support the development of styles of play for BYSC competitive teams.
 - Plan and implement off field fitness, agility and mental training programs.
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- Administration
 - Coordinate and administer the Club's policies as defined by its Board of Directors.
 - Prepare player evaluations.
- Customer Service & External Relations
 - Support the quality of the Club's services, ensuring maximum membership satisfaction.
 - Participate in outside activities that are judged as appropriate and approved by the Executive Director to enhance the prestige of the Club.
 - Broaden the scope of the Club by fulfilling public obligations as a participating member of the Burlington Community, where needed.
