SCOPE:

The position assists with the management of all aspects of the OPDL team including its games, practices, off field activities and program/season planning.

 - Travel with the team and attend all competitions.
 - Assist head coach with scouting, identification and selection of players into the OPDL team.
 - Support the development of styles of play for BYSC competitive teams.
 - Assist age group head coach implement off field fitness, agility and mental training programs.
- Coaching Development
 - Attend coaching education sessions and clinics where appropriate.
 - Attend Ontario Soccer Summit if requested
- Administration
 - Assist head coach prepare player evaluations.
