BURLINGTON YOUTH SOCCER CLUB:

The Burlington Youth Soccer Club (BYSC), a not-for-profit organization, was established in 1962 and celebrated its 50th anniversary in 2012. Today, the Club has approximately 7,000 female and male youth soccer players and is one of the largest soccer Clubs in Ontario. The BYSC is home to the Burlington Bayhawks and is proud of its competitive team successes over the years, which includes 42 provincial championships and 13 national championships.

SCOPE:

The Player Development Coach is a member of the BYSC Technical Team. Reporting to the Development Phase Manager, this position is responsible for providing coaching leadership and assists with overseeing the development of the Club's technical strategy including the player development and coaching development pathway that is aligned with the Club's Vision and Mission.

KEY ROLES, RESPONSIBILITIES & DUTIES:

The recreational program coach shall lead practice sessions for our recreational programs on weekends during the fall and winter season. They are a key point of contact on field with the players and should be engaging, outgoing and with an ability to demonstrate soccer related skills. Experience and understanding of basic Soccer techniques is required. Coaching experience is strongly preferred. Must work well with other coaches, be punctual and efficient with their time and be able to follow a coaching curriculum.

You will receive mentoring support but should also be able to work of their own volition with minimal supervision.

The programs run Monday – Wednesday, 6-8pm, Friday 5:45 – 7:15pm and Saturday 9am – 11:30am but other hours may open up as we progress through the season. The role begins immediately until August 7th. It is expected the incumbent be available for ALL stated hours above. Pay rate is hourly based on experience and qualifications.
