BURLINGTON SOCCER CLUB:

The Burlington Soccer Club (BYSC), a not-for-profit organization, was established in 1962 and celebrated its 50th anniversary in 2012. Today, the Club has over 7,900 female and male youth soccer players and is one of the largest soccer Clubs in Ontario. The BYSC is home to the Burlington Bayhawks and is proud of its competitive team successes over the years, including 42 provincial championships and 13 national championships.

SCOPE:

Under the direction of the Foundation Phase Manager the successful candidates will assist in technical delivery and coaching of the clubs Summer Soccer Skills program and House league sessions. The primary responsibility for this role will be coaching the Summer Soccer Skills program. Additional hours in further programs may also be assigned if available.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES & DUTIES:

Coaching

- Lead or assist weekly coaching sessions and clinics with young soccer players in a fun and engaging environment, including but not limited to Soccer skills training and recreational programs.
- Lead volunteer Coaches.
- Set up and take down of equipment, as well as potential holding of equipment between events.
- Communicate with parents about a participant's experiences and report concerns to senior staff.
- Assist in maintaining accurate program records including incident reports, logbook documentation and daily attendance.

Customer Service & External Relations

- Promote youth soccer within the community.
- Participate in outside activities that are judged as appropriate and approved by the Executive Director to enhance the prestige of the Club.
- Broaden the scope of the Club by fulfilling public obligations as a participating member of the Burlington Community.





EXPERIENCE & QUALIFICATIONS:

- Willingness to work evenings and weekends is required.
- Ability to lead, plan, organize and implement program activities.
- Event and community engagement experience is an asset.
- Soccer background with the ability to participate with kids.
 - Completion of either OSA coaching course is an asset.
- Energetic, outgoing, confident and enthusiastic personality.
- Must have the physical ability to lead and participate in activities.
- Ability to multi-task with changing priorities and flexibility to work in multiple areas.
- Demonstrated experience in working within a team environment and committed to exceptional customer service.
- Valid Police check from within the past 3 years or willingness to obtain/renew if needs be before starting the role.
